Overall focus for the unit: To understand the importance of managing money. To include; ○ Importance of planning and managing a budget ○ Functions and use of money ○ Wants Vs needs ○ Financial transactions and financial products.	Overall focus for the unit: To understand the effects of alcohol, not just on those who consume it, but others. To include; ○ Dangers of alcohol – including on others ○ Short and long term effects of alcohol ○ Crime and substance abuse ○ Illegal and legal drugs	Overall focus for the unit: To consider why we always need to remain safe and consider the risks when faced with risky situations. To include; ○ Online grooming ○ CSE ○ Knife crime ○ Domestic conflict – risks of running away from home.	Overall focus for the unit: To understand the different types of contraception and how to maintain good sexual health. To include; ○ Importance of consent ○ Safe sex – different types of contraception ○ Good sexual health – avoiding STIs ○ Pregnancy – including teenage pregnancy and abortion	Overall focus for the unit: To consider how things such as domestic violence and FGM can impact people. To include; ○ Sexting and pornography – what they are and risks associated ○ Domestic violence ○ FGM and its impact – including seeking help ○ LGBT+ community – including discrimination



Intent behind the unit: It is important that pupils are aware of how to manage money and the different functions of money. At this point pupils start to get pocket money and for some they will want to spend it straight away, whilst others might want to save it.	Intent behind the unit: This unit builds on their year 7 unit where looked at the effects of cigarettes and vaping, they are not looking at the dangers of alcohol as for some of our pupils they will be living in households where drinking is the 'norm' and pupils may have older siblings who find themselves drinking at the weekend and getting into trouble through doing so.	Intent behind the unit: This unit builds on a unit from year 8 where pupils looked at how to enjoy social media safely. This is now designed taking that a step further and look at the risks associated with being online. Knife crime and CSE are issues which are becoming more of an issue in the country, therefore we are addressing this issues at a time when we feel the pupils have an element of maturity which will allow them to do so.	Intent behind the unit: In year 7 pupils looked at how to build positive relationships, they are now building on this and looking at the importance of consent and how consent can apply to any situation. Pupils also need to be aware to be aware of the different types of contraception etc and how to make safe, informed decisions.	Intent behind the unit: FGM, sexting and pornography are raising in profile amongst children, therefore it is our job to inform pupils of the risks associated with some of these issues and how to seek help if they are impacted by such issues. Also, pupils are starting to develop their sexuality, therefore it is important that as a school we address these issues and make the pupils feel supported as they go through this decision making process.
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
